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ALISAL UNION SCHOOL DISTRICT NON-COMPLIANT FUNDRAISER PROCEDURES (Candy, Donuts, Cookie Dough, Frozen Pizza, and Other Frozen Food Products)

A competitive food is one that is “sold” to a student during the school day, on the school campus, outside the meal program. “Sold” means the exchange of a food or beverage for money. Therefore, if there is no physical exchange of a food or beverage, there is no competitive food sale. So, money, order forms, etc., can be passed back and forth during the school day and it does not constitute a competitive sale. The “sale” occurs with the exchange of the food or beverage for money. Sites can distribute order forms, collect order forms, and money during school hours.

1. Picking up frozen food items: Parents are allowed to pick up ordered items immediately after school; students are not allowed to pick up ordered items. Candy bars may be given to students at the end of the school day in sealed boxes. The students will be instructed not to open boxes until they have left the school campus.
2. On the Application to Raise Funds Form, you are to inform the Food Service Office date you anticipate distributing the food items. You will also need to inform parents when and where they will be able to pick up ordered items.
3. The distribution and sorting of these sales should not interfere with the normal activities at school (i.e., lunch, custodial, etc.). Sorting of these items should occur in an area where students do not have access to the food being sold.

Food Services areas are **NOT** allowed to store any leftover items, so please make arrangements with your vendors.
